The Environment Protection Authority (the Authority), pursuant to section 49 1(a) of the *Environment Protection Act 1997* (the Act), hereby authorises:

for the purpose of: **Corinbank Festival**  
on: Rural Block: **217, 218**  
District: **Paddys River:**

subject to the conditions set out in **Schedule 1** attached. The authorisation is valid from **Friday 30 November to Sunday 2 December 2012** or until earlier surrendered by Resonate Pty Ltd or cancelled or suspended by the Authority.

This is a **standard** environmental authorisation.

## SCHEDULE 1

### CONDITIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF Corinbank Festival Rural Block: 217, 218 District Paddys River

Note: This schedule should be read in conjunction with the Noise Environment Protection Policy.

#### (1) Definitions

*compliance location* – has the same meaning as in the *Environment Protection Regulation 2005*.

*event* - activity which involves:

- an outdoor concert using amplifying equipment.

*noise limit* - the maximum noise from the outdoor concerts permitted at the Compliance Location.

#### (2) Hours of Operation

Outdoor concert events may only be conducted From Friday 30 November 2012 12.00(midday)and conclude on Sunday 2 December 2012 (10pm)

Sound checks may be conducted for a maximum period of 60 minutes between the hours of 2.00 (pm) and 6.00 (pm) on Thursday 29 November 2012 and a maximum of 60 minutes between 9.00 (am) and 11 (am) on Friday 30 November 2012 only.

#### (3) Noise Emissions

Noise levels at the Compliance Location must not exceed the following:

Friday 30 November 2012

12 midday to 10pm 50dB(A)<sub>LA10</sub>,

10pm to 7am 40dB(A)<sub>LA10</sub>

Saturday 1 December 2012

7am to 10pm 50dB(A)<sub>LA10</sub>,

10pm to 8am 40dB(A)<sub>LA10</sub>

Sunday 2 December 2012

8am to 10pm 50dB(A)<sub>LA10</sub>, 10 minutes at Compliance Location.

- (4) **Compliance Requirements** Amplified music may only be conducted as part of the Corinbank Festival.

Amplified music may only be conducted during the permitted hours detailed in Clause 2 and within the noise limits set out in Clause 3 of this Schedule.

- (5) **Compliance Location** The driveway entrance to 50 Corin Road, Rural Block 1, District Paddys River

- (6) **Monitoring / Reporting** The Authorisation holder is required to demonstrate that noise from the event does not exceed the noise limits at the Compliance Location. The Authorisation holder must submit a Noise Management Plan prepared by a person suitable qualified in the assessment of environmental noise to the Authority before the event. The proposal must be acceptable to the Authority.

In the absence of a proposal, monitoring will be by means of independent noise monitoring at the compliance location for each event. Noise monitoring must be undertaken by an accredited acoustic consultant, experienced in environmental noise assessment, who is a member of the Australian Acoustical Society. This must be attended monitoring. Parameters to be monitored are LA10 and L90, 10 min.

- (7) **Written Report** Noise monitoring results measured during the event must be provided, in writing to the Authority by **close of business 6 February 2013.**

The written reports must contain the following information:

- (a) the name, address and telephone number(s) of the person who prepared the report;
- (b) the dates, commencement and completion times of sound measurements;
- (c) a description of the point(s) at which the sound measurement(s) were taken;

- (d) details of the equipment and methods used to take the sound measurements;
- (e) details of any measured non-compliances associated with noise emissions from the concert events, including noise readings obtained, and what actions were taken to ensure compliance with the requirements of Clause 3 of this schedule; and
- (f) qualification of the person undertaking the noise assessment.

**(8) Record of complaints**

The Authorisation holder shall keep a record of all complaints received by its employees or its agents, in relation to noise emissions from the events. This record is to be provided, on request, to the Authority.

**(9) Contact details**

The Authorisation holder shall provide to the Authority, prior to the commencement of the event, contact details for person(s) with principal control of the event. Any person nominated by the Authorisation holder to meet the requirements of this condition shall be readily contactable on the person's nominated telephone number(s) during the event.

**(10) Plan of Management for Liquid Waste**

The Authorisation holder shall provide a Plan of Management for the site in relation to the control of liquid wastes from caravans, food vans and any other sources of waste, which is likely to enter the stormwater system. This plan must be provided to the Authority in advance of the event.
